

## **LWVFL Returning Citizens Postcard Mailings Project**

On September 17th eleven members of the Historic Bethel AME's Justice Ministry, led by Mildred Reed, and LWVSPA Pat Lucas and Maryellen Gordon wrote postcards to returning citizens as part of the league's continuing postcard campaign. One hundred and thirty cards were written and mailed. LWVFL's goal is to mail 100,000 cards by November. Statewide, 80,000 have been sent to date.

The evergreen shrub <u>Wild Coffee</u> and the low growing groundcover <u>Blue Porterweed</u> are two species we're spotlighting this month.

Both are practically indestructible, which is great for us horticulturally challenged folks. In fact, one great benefit of planting natives in your yard is that no matter what you do you can't kill them, and many multiply like rabbits. The links will take you to the Florida Wildflower Foundation. Learn interesting facts about these plants as well as how to successfully grow them.

Many species in our garden are flourishing this season (do we have seasons in Florida?), so if you're interested in a visual treat stop by the garden at Sanderlin. You can watch the Dune Sunflower grow - literally while you're standing there!
