Universal Curbside Recycling

Calling All League Members: The People's Trash Needs You Thursday, February 20th



In April 2013, our League launched an advocacy campaign urging that universal curbside recycling service be offered to all St. Petersburg households. We formed a coalition with CONA (Council of Neighborhood Associations), The People's Budget Review, and The Suncoast Sierra Club called "The People's Trash." Our efforts are now coming to fruition. On *Thursday, February 20th*, city staff will propose

a service to City Council that meets most of the characteristics that the coalition recommended. A leader from each coalition partner will speak in support of the staff proposal.

We need League members to attend! Please wear League pins and pick up a "Support Recycling" sticker provided by the coalition. A big crowd will send a powerful message to our City Council and the citizens of our city.

Please join the St. Petersburg Area League of Women Voters at noon on Saturday, April 26th, at the St. Petersburg Yacht Club for an exciting opportunity to meet and hear the iconic former 12-term Congresswoman Pat Schroeder, tireless champion for reproductive and women's rights, workplace reforms, and the rights of families and members of the United States military.

Schroeder, the first woman from Colorado elected to the House of Representatives, demonstrated the success of combining a demanding career with raising her children, and battled the deeply entrenched beliefs held by some of her colleagues that work and politics "is no place for a woman."

At the April 26th luncheon, she will receive the St. Petersburg League's second 'Making Democracy Work' award, last presented in 2011 to former Florida governor Charlie Crist.
